St Leonards Church contains a collection of Hatchments and other artworks that are of National significance, covering a period of over 200 years of Deal's proud history as a Naval Port.

Local Admirals and Naval heroes, sea battles and disastrous storms are commemorated alongside the general population and the contribution they all made to Deal. However the ravages of time threaten to deprive future generations of this great heritage which our predecessors protected for us, unless we do something now!
